Message from the Principal

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Applications for Extended Leave

As a school we recognise that there are times when families wish to travel outside of the usual holiday periods. Reasons could include availability of cheap flights, a family holiday overseas or to visit family and friends who live far away. To better support the school please be reminded of the following:

- Parents / Carers need to inform the front office at the earliest opportunity of their travel intentions and complete an Application for Extended Leave – Travel.
- An appointment needs to be made with the Principal or Deputy Principal to discuss this application.
- Copies of the travel documents including dates of travel need to be provided.

At the interview with the Principal or Deputy Principal the Application for Extended Leave – Travel will be discussed, considered and either Approved or Declined.

If the Application for Extended Leave – Travel is approved, a Certificate of Extended Leave – Travel will be issued and the student's absence will be recorded as Leave. If the Application for Extended Leave – Travel is declined and the leave is still taken, the absence will be recorded as Unjustified. It must be mentioned that the majority of Applications for Extended Leave – Travel are approved.

However, at times for educational reasons these applications are declined. Reasons could include:

- No notice was given and therefore no interview could be arranged.
- The student has already missed too many school days impacting on learning.

Attendance—It Matters

Where possible arrange dental and medical appointments after school. When this is not possible, ensure your child attends school before and after the appointment and let the school know in advance. There have been a large number of students consistently late in the morning which means they miss out on the morning assembly and important classroom routines. Please ensure your child is at school ready to start the day on time at 8:55am.

Holidays

Have a safe and happy holiday. Term 2 ends Friday 30 June. Students return on Tuesday 18 July. There will be a School Development Day (student free) on Monday 17 July where the staff will be focussing on visible learning, Aboriginal education and refugee education.
